RESOLUTION SUPPORTING INSTALLATION OF A CROSSWALK WITH SAFETY
LIGHTS NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF CALIFORNIA STREET AND VINE STREET

WHEREAS, the public welfare, necessity and convenience require a crosswalk to safely cross California Street, a four-lane, high volume roadway;

WHEREAS, the Behavioral Health Services campus is the main mental health service provider in Stockton, California and fronts nearly a quarter mile of California Street without a crosswalk;

WHEREAS, there is not safe pedestrian access to and from the Behavioral Health Services campus to cross California Street;

WHEREAS, pedestrians require safe access to and from Behavioral Health Services, transit stops and the local neighborhood;

WHEREAS, the installation of a crosswalk will provide safe pedestrian access to services offered by Behavioral Health Services and the Public Guardian/Conservator's Office;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Behavioral Health Board does hereby support the Power and Support Team's request to the City of Stockton to install a crosswalk near the intersection of California Street and Vine Street.
